As a volunteer in the New Jersey State Bar Association's Mass Disaster Response Program and the Legal Assistance Program sponsored by the Young Lawyers Division of the New Jersey State Bar Association (collectively, "the Program") to provide legal assistance to victims of the recent disaster in New Jersey known as Hurricane Sandy, I hereby make the following pledge:

- I am willing to provide disaster assistance information to victims referred to me for assistance from the New Jersey State Bar Association through the Program.
- I shall accept no financial gain for providing needed information to disaster victims or their families referred to me through the Program.
- Neither I nor any firm with which I am associated shall accept any remuneration from any person with whom I have been in contact by reason of my participation in the Program, even if such person so requests. Neither I nor any such firm will be precluded from representing such person on a pro bono basis.
- I shall not take any action which may reasonably appear to be an attempt to solicit disaster-related business for myself or for any other attorney through my participation in the Program.
- Should I choose to undertake actual legal representation of any person in a disaster-related case on a pro bono basis as a result of my participation in the Program, it is understood that this would be done in my individual capacity as an attorney and not as a representative or agent of the New Jersey State Bar Association or its Young Lawyers Division.
